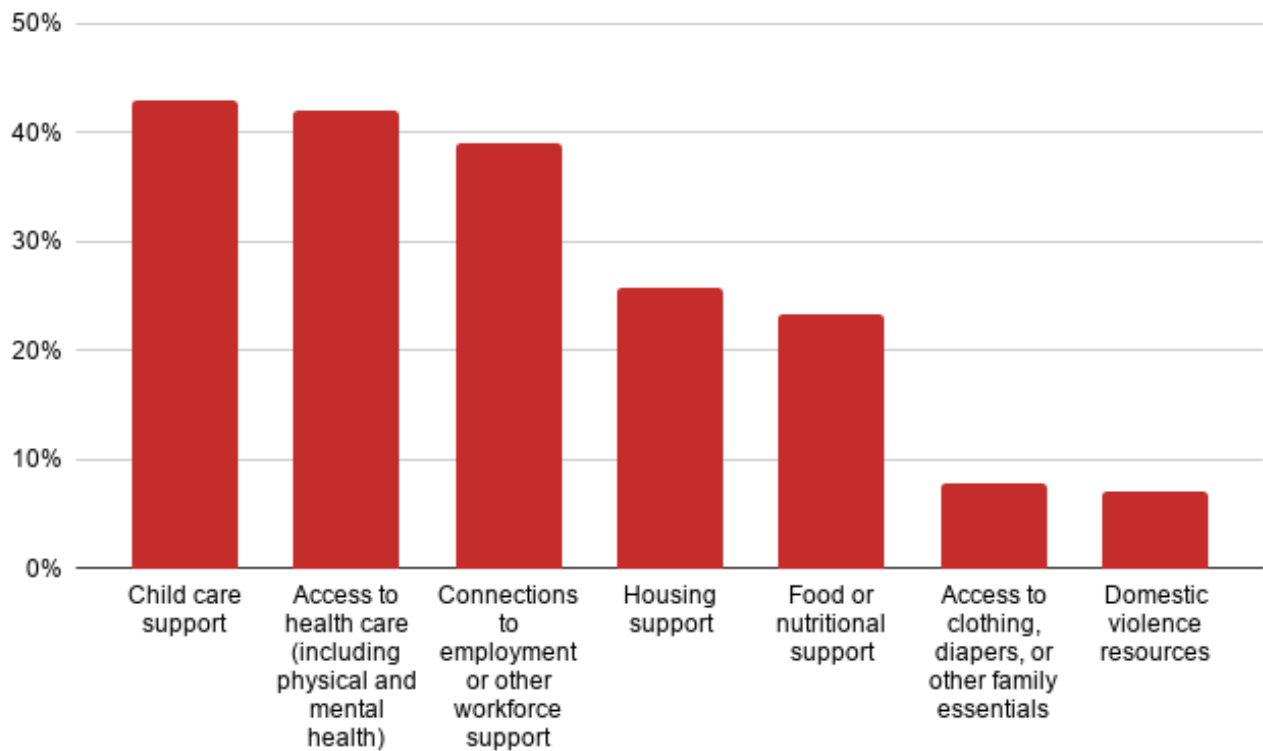


Impact of COVID-19 on Loudoun Women

UNMET NEEDS REPORTED BY WOMEN

The Loudoun Commission on Women and Girls surveyed women living in Loudoun County about the impact of COVID-19 on their lives. Out of nearly 400 respondents, one third of women identified having one or more unmet needs. The chart below illustrates the top issues for community leaders to address.

Women or their spouses who lost jobs or are working fewer hours.

72%

Women living in 72% of Loudoun County's zip codes were surveyed.

76%

Respondents who were between ages 24-55 years old.

WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

LCWAG seeks to improve our outreach with the African-American, Asian, and Hispanic/Latina communities to be more representative of Loudoun County's demographics. Future research will focus on understanding of the top three unmet needs: child care, health care, and economics and employment issues. The next survey opens in April.
